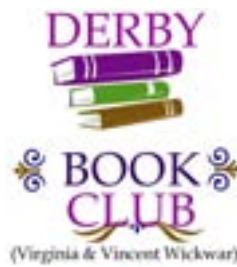

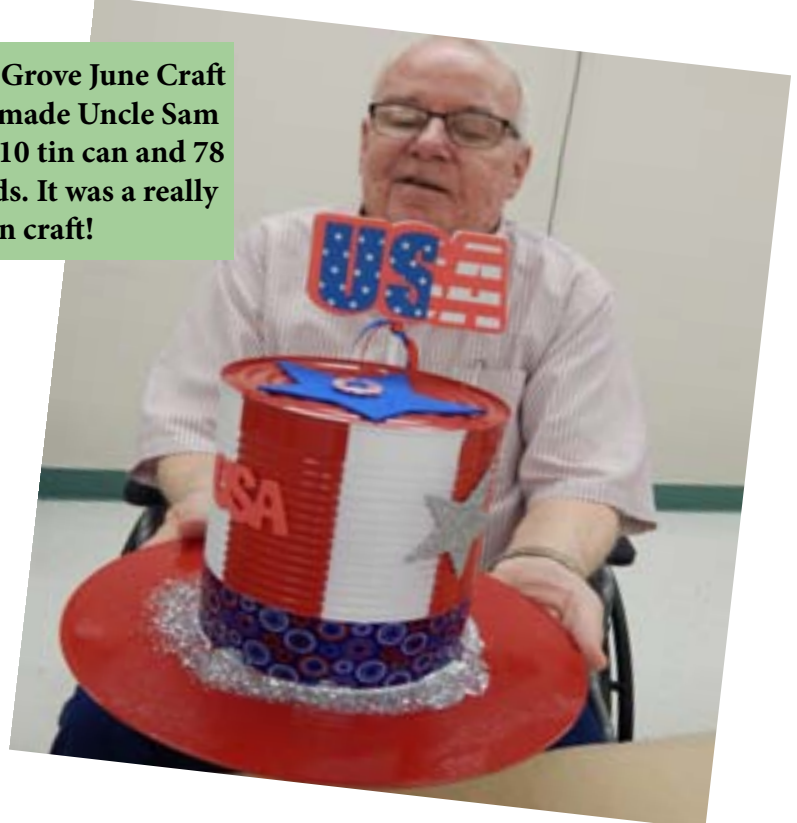
Annual Fish Fry: All of our residents enjoyed the fish that were caught the day before.

We joined Summerfest again this year by having the local band Relic give a concert at our facility.



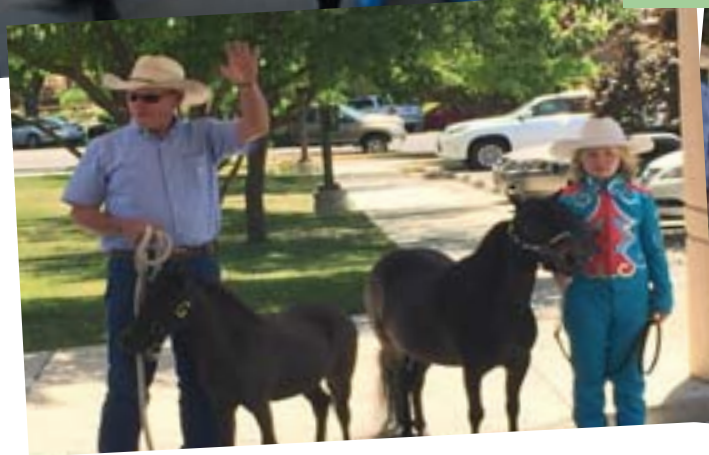
Shirley Reeder and her son Dwight Reeder from the Wichita Tribe out of Oklahoma, who came and did a cultural program on the Native American Pow Wows
