A couple of local snake breeders stopped by with a few of their amazing specimens. The residents asked them a ton of questions and were able to pet and hold the snakes.



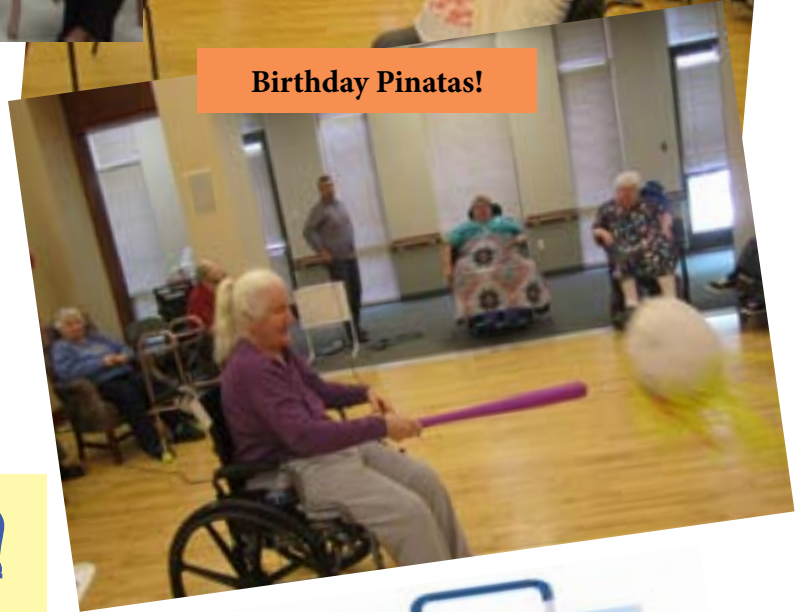
